Scout Promise:

Existing

On my honour, I promise that I will do my best
To do my duty to God and to the Queen,
To help other people
And to keep the Cub/Scout Law.

Alternative

To uphold our Scout values, to do my duty to the Queen,
To help other people
And to keep the Scout Law.

*N.B. The **alternative** is only to be used if parents do not want their child to 'do their duty to God'.*

Cub Scout Promise

Existing

I promise that I will do my best
to do my duty to God and to the Queen
to help other people
and to keep the Cub Scout Law

*N.B. This is the **preferred** promise. Check with parents before investiture that they are happy with this*

Alternative

I promise that I will do my best
To uphold our Scout values, to do my duty to the Queen,
To help other people
And to keep the Cub Scout Law.

*N.B. The **alternative** is only to be used if parents do not want their child to 'do their duty to God'.*

Beaver Scout Promise

Existing

I promise to do my best
to be kind and helpful
and to love God

*N.B. This is the **preferred** promise. Check with parents before investiture that they are happy with this*

Alternative

I promise to do my best
To be kind and helpful
and to love our world.

*N.B. The **alternative** is only to be used if parents do not want their child to 'do their duty to God'.*
